


Sail Boat Romper For Baby Free Crochet Pattern



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MATERIALS: 2 skeins Pale Blue Bernat Softee Baby, 1 skein ea Bernat Softee Baby in Lemon, White and Dreamy Blue, 24 size 1½” 2 part snaps and snap applicator tool or snap lining (found in most fabric stores), size F hook or hook to obtain gauge and needle to take yarn.

Please Note: Since making these rompers I have discovered snap tape. It is exactly what it is called: a series of snaps attached to webbed tape that you sew to the garment. They hold up much better to snapping and re-snapping. Snap tape is found at most fabric stores in the notions aisle--it will need to be cut to length. One yard should be enough.

GAUGE: 1 square = 1-1½”

FINISHED SIZE: 15-1½” width, 7” wide ea leg, 7-1½” long leg to crotch

BASIC BLOCK:

With F hook and yarn, ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, (3 sc, ch-2) 4 times in ring, sl st top beg sc, DO NOT TURN.

RND 2: Ch-3 (1st dc), dc in next 2 sts, *(dc, ch-2, dc) in corner, dc next 3 sts, rep from * 3 times, (dc, ch-2, dc) last corner, sl st top beg ch-3, fasten off. One block made.

JOINING RND: as in rnd 2, ch-3 (1st dc), dc next 2 sts, (dc, ch-1,) next corner, ch-1 in corresponding corner of block 2, dc in same corner on block 1, dc next 2 sts, sl st in same st corresponding block, dc next st, (dc, ch-1) next corner, ch-1, in next corresponding corner of block 2, dc in same corner block 1, *dc next 3 sts, (dc, ch-2, dc) next corner, rep from * twice, sl st top beg ch-3, fasten off.

TWO COLOR BLOCK:

With F hook and color A, ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

RND 1: Ch-1, *3 sc, ch-2, 3 sc ch-1* join in color B and continuing to work color A in back of sts, ch-1, rep between *'s, pick up color A, ch-1, sl st top beg sc.

RND 2: Working color A and carrying color B behind worked sts: Ch-3 (1st dc), dc next 2 sts, (dc, ch-2, dc) next corner, dc next 3 sts, (dc, ch-1) next corner, pick up color B, (ch-1, dc) same corner, now working color A behind sts as you work dc next 3 sts, (dc, ch-2, dc) next corner, dc next 3 sts, (dc, ch-1) next corner, pick up A, (ch-1, dc) as corner, sl st top beg ch-3, fasten off.

Join as for basic block only continuing two-color block as established.

Work romper according to graph.

HALF BLOCK:

With Pale Blue and F hook ch-4, sl st to form a ring.

ROW 1: Ch-1, work 4 sc, ch-2, 4 sc in ring, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 2 (JOINING ROW): Ch-3, sl st in corresponding block's ch-2 corner sp, dc next 2 sts, sl st corresponding dc on 2nd block, dc next st, dc, ch-1, in ch-2 sp, sl st corresponding ch-2 sp 2nd block, ch-1, dc same sp as last dc, dc next st, sl st corresponding dc 2nd block, dc next 2 sts, sl st corresponding dc 2nd block, dc next 2 sts, sl st corresponding ch-2 sp 2nd block, fasten off.

FINISHING:

With needle and matching yarn sew the romper tog at sides.

Following manufacture instructions apply 12 snaps along crotch and leg evenly spacing. (1 ea sq) Apply 2 snaps across ea strap short (front strap) and 4-spacing two sets of two snaps evenly, on longer back strap. Sew the sides tog at the legs, 11-1½” up from bottom edge of leg. Apply two snaps 15” above bottom edge of leg and 16” above bottom edge of leg. If you prefer, sew the snap tape following the same directions.

Abbreviations Used In This Pattern


Ch = Chain
St = Stitch
Sl St = Slip Stitch
Sc = Single Crochet
Dc = Double Crochet
Rnd = Round
Beg = Beginning
Rep = Repeat
Bet = Between
Ea = Each
Tog = Together

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
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1 sq = 1/3"
